The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences administers admission to the major in Art History; however, the Program in Art History advises all Art History majors.

The curriculum in Art History requires 120 credit hours and offers a broad historical and cultural education related to the visual and build world. The curriculum provides sound preparation for the graduate study required for museum work or teaching at the college level.
